#### **Read This Manual**

Inside you'll find many helpful hints on how to use and maintain your Electric Griddle properly. Just a little preventive care on your part can save you a great deal of time and money over the life of your appliance.

These instructions may not cover every possible condition of use, so attention to safety details is required when operating and maintaining this product.



- This appliance is not intended for use by people (including children) with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities or lack of experience and kno wledge, unless they have been provided with supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance by a person responsible for their safety.
- Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
- The appliance shall be installed in accordance with national wiring regulations.

#### Welcome

You are about to see how quick, easy, and delicious healthy eating can be!

Please read all the safety information, warnings, and instructional material found in this booklet before getting start. Set your machine on a dry, level surface.

Then, follow the cleaning instructions to prepare your machine for use. Always clean your machine before the first use.

## SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

When using your electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric hazard and injury to persons, including the following.

- 1. Read All Instructions.
- 2. Do not touch hot surface. Use handles or buttons of control panel. The unit body will become very hot during long-time using, handle it carefully.
- 3. CAUTION: To reduce the risk or electric shock, cook only in removable container.
- 4. Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- 5. To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plug, or cooker body in water or other liquid.
- 6. Do not add too much water beyond the edge of the porcelain inner pot, or the water will flow out during cooking.
- 7. Unplug from outlet when do not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- 8. Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- 9. The use of accessory attachment not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- 10. Intended for countertop use only.
- 11. Do not use the appliance for other than intended use.
- 12. Do not use outdoors.
- 13. Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing other hot liquids.
- 14. Do not let cord hang over edge of table and counter, or touch hot surface.
- 15. A short power-supply cord is used to reduce the risk resulting from it being grabbed by children, becoming entangled in, or tripping over a longer cord.
- 16. WARNING: Spilled food can cause serious burns. Keep appliance and cord away from children. Never drape cord over edge of counter, never use outlet below counter, and never use with an extension cord.
- 17. Prior to first use, please make sure that the electric rating of the appliance is in conformity with the current electric rating.
- 18. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- 19. DO NOT place unit on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- 20. DO NOT put frozen articles inside the porcelain pot when it is too much heat, nor do wash the porcelain pot with the cold water.

Appliances are not intended to be operated by means of an external timer or separate remote-control system.

- 21. DO NOT uncover the lid when in stewing, otherwise the heat will run out and more stewing time will be needed.
- 22. DO NOT cooking food directly in the Aluminum pot.
- 23. DO NOT place the porcelain inner pot on gas stove.
- 24. To avoid any cracks or spoilage that may bring to the slow cooker, proper maintenance is necessary...
- 25. Only carry the slow cooker from the side handles on the cooking base. Do NOT carry from the handle on the lid ,even when locked.
- 26. This appliance has a polarized plug (one blade is wider than the other). To reduce the risk of electric shock, this plug is intended to fit into a polarized outlet only one way. If the plug does not fit fully into the outlet, reverse the plug. If it still does not fit, contact a qualified electrician. Do not attempt to modify the plug in any way
- 27. HOUSEHOLD USE ONLY.

WARNING: The appliance must never be used with oil, it should not be used as a frying pan or deep fat fryer!

## **HOW TO USE**

1 Insert the power plug to make sure it is plugged in.



- 3 Put the seasoning in the baking pan.
- 5 Put on the glass cover, start cooking, open the glass cover and stir the food at the right time to ensure uniform heating.



2 Turn the adjusting knob in the front to the high temperature gear.



4 Add food.



6 After cooking, unplug the power cord and wipe the baking tray with a wet towel after cooling down.



## **CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE**

- Please be sure to unplug the power cord plug after each use, wait for a few minutes after power failure, and then wipe it with a damp cloth. If it is stored for a long time, it should be cleaned with detergent.
- Do not use abrasive cleaning products or solvents for cleaning.
- Do not put the product in water for cleaning in case of electric shock and malfunction.
- Dry all components before storage and put the product in a safe and dry place.
