

## Troubleshooting Guide

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vehicle does not run	Battery low on power	Recharge battery.
	Thermal fuse has tripped	The fuse will reset automatically in 20 seconds.
	Battery connector or wires are loose	Check that the battery connectors are firmly plugged into each other. If wires are loose around the motor <b>contact your distributor please.</b>
	Battery is dead	Replace battery, <b>contact your distributor please.</b>
	Electrical system is damaged	<b>Contact your distributor please.</b>
	Motor is damaged	<b>Contact your distributor please.</b>
Vehicle does not run very long	Battery is under charged	Check that the battery connectors are firmly plugged into each other when recharging
	Battery is old	Replace battery, <b>contact your distributor please.</b>
Vehicle runs sluggishly	Battery low on power	Recharge battery, <b>contact your distributor please.</b>
	Battery is old	Replace battery, <b>contact your distributor please.</b>
	Vehicle is overload	Reduce weight on vehicle. Maximum user weight is 50 kg.
	Vehicle is being used in harsh conditions	Avoid using vehicle in harsh conditions ,see <Safety>.
Vehicle needs a push to go forward	Poor contact of wires or Connectors	Check that the battery connectors are firmly plugged into each other. If wires are loose around the motor, <b>contact your distributor please.</b>
	"Dead Spot" on motor	A dead spot means the electric power is not being delivered to the terminal connection and the vehicle needs repair. <b>Contact your distributor please.</b>
Difficult shifting from forward to reverse or vice-versa	Attempting to shift while the vehicle is motion	Completely stop the vehicle and shift, see <Use Your New Vehicle>
Loud grinding or clicking noises coming from motor or gear box	Motor or gears are damaged	<b>Contact your distributor please.</b>
Battery will not recharge	Battery connector or adapter connector is loose	Check that the battery connectors are firmly plugged into each other.
	Charger not plugged in	Check that the battery charger is plugged into a working wall outlet.
	Charger is not working	<b>Contact your distributor please.</b>
Charger feels warm when recharging	This is normal and not a cause for concern

#### PREVENT INJURIES AND DEATHS:

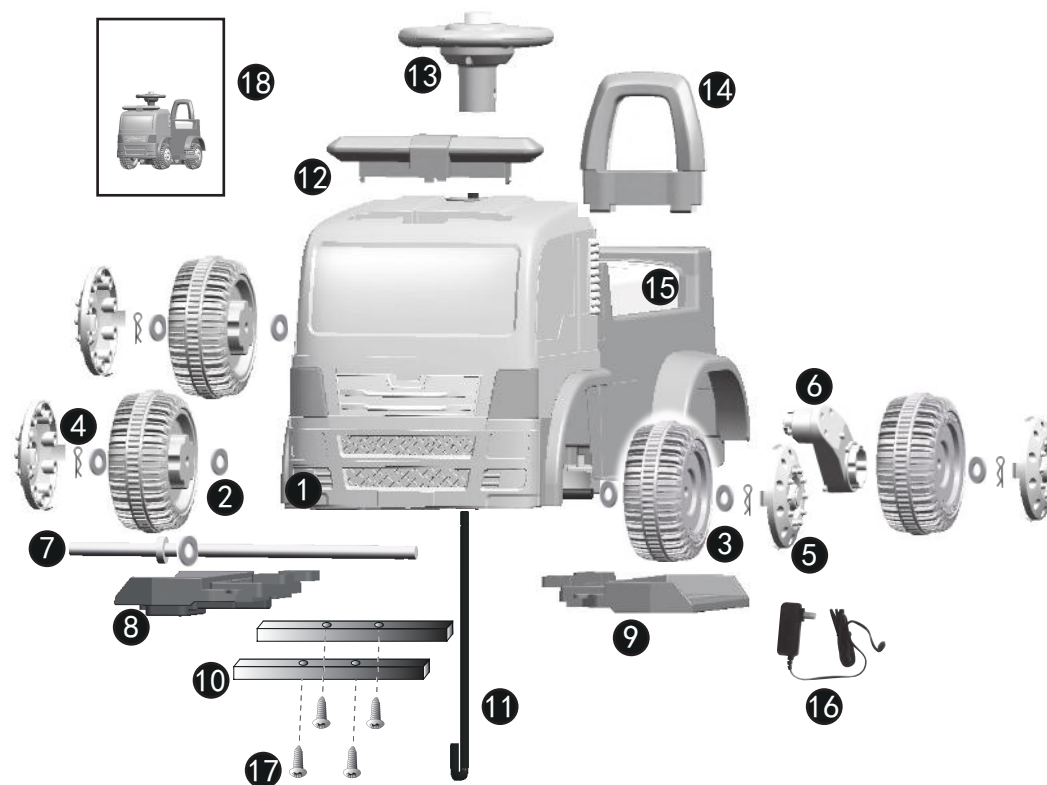

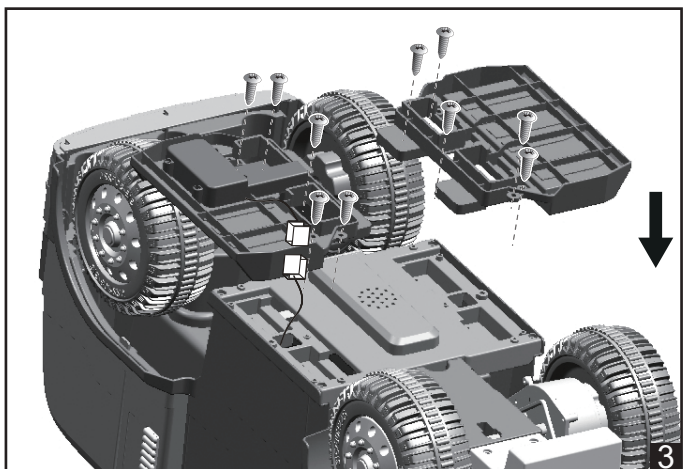
## How to assemble



1. Add gasket, wheel, gasket, cotter and wheel cover to each side of steering wheel one by one. (P1)

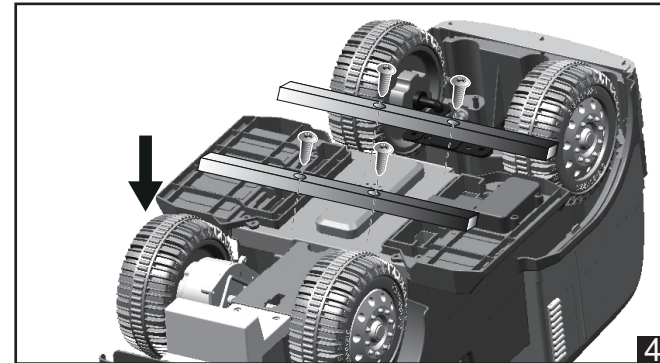


2. Add one gasket to rear axle from the right side, insert rear axle to car body. Add motor to the right side and add gasket to the left side. Then add wheel, gasket, cotter and wheel cover one by one. (P2)

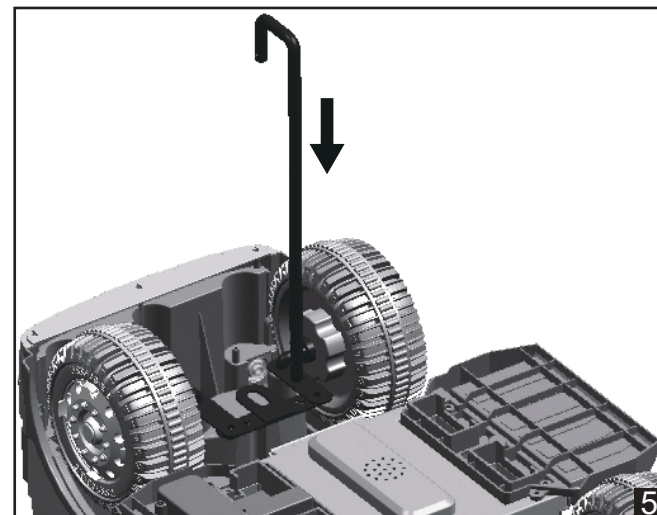


3. Connect two terminals of car body and foot rest, then assemble two foot rest according to the arrow and use 10pcs M4\*12 screw to tighten. (P3)

## How to assemble

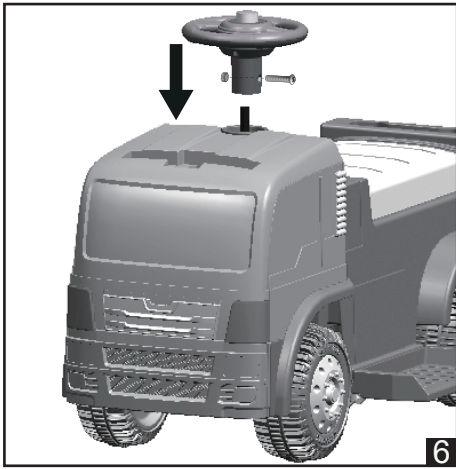


4. Assemble two square tubes to the car body according to the arrow, then use 4pcs M4\*12 screw to tighten.

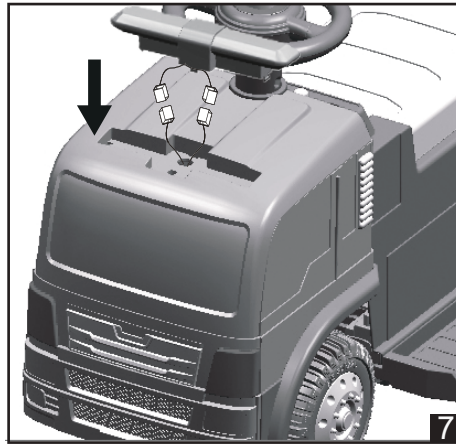


5. Insert the steering lever to the car body according to the arrow, then turn over body by holding up steering lever, in order to it falls.

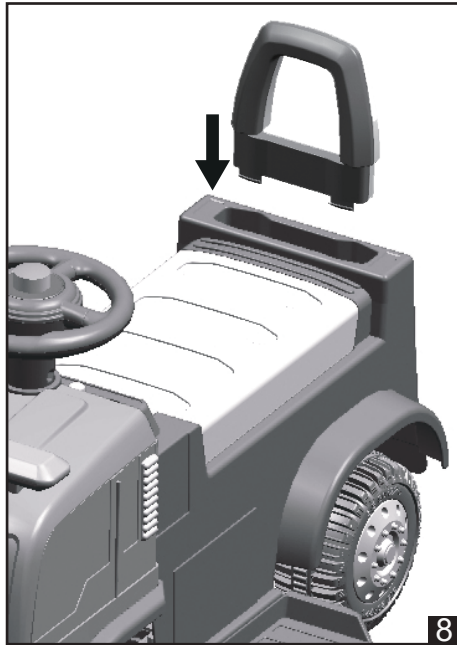

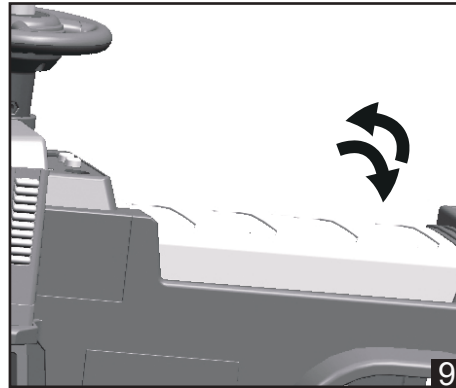
6. Insert steering wheel into the steering lever, then use screw to tighten. (P6)



7. Connect two terminals of the alarm lamp and car body, insert alarm lamp to the car body according to the arrow. (P7)

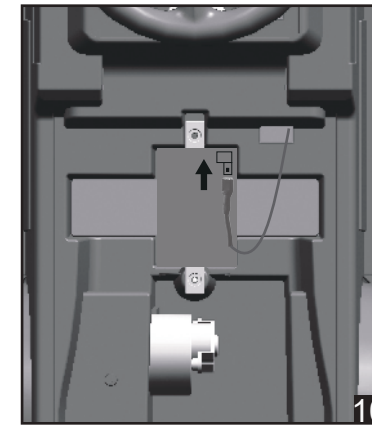


8. Insert the back rest in the car body. (P8)

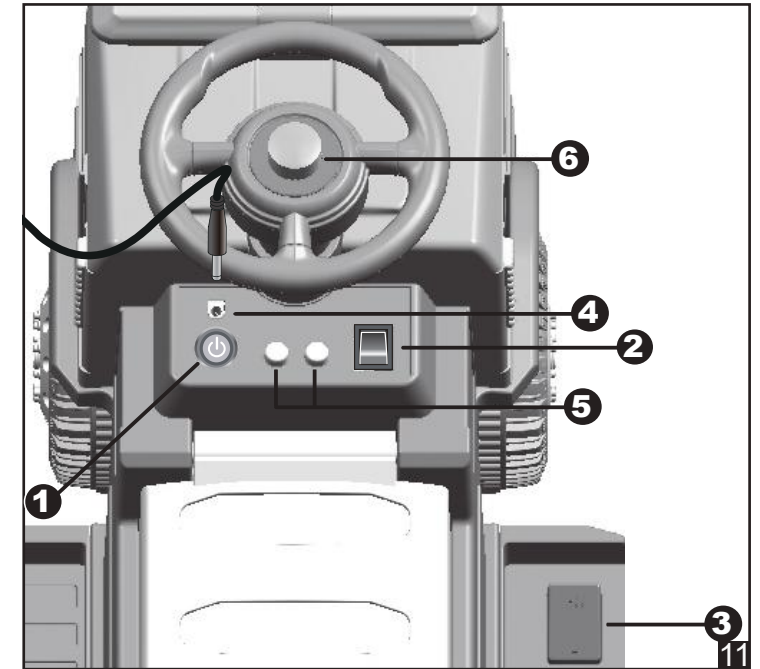


9. Open the seat according to the arrow. (P9)

## Function



10. Connect the red line to the red terminal of battery. (P10)



- 1** Turn the power, car is ready to play.
- 2** Forward, stop, backward button controls forward, stop, backward.
- 3** Step pedal switch, press forward button, car moves forward, press stop, car stops, press backward, car moves backward.
- 4** Charging hole is over the power switch. When power is low, please recharge. Car can not play when it is charging. Charging should be done by adults.)
- 5** Press music button for alarm sound and song. Press bellows button for "BEEP" sound
